Opening Announcements: Thanks to Bob for taking notes.

Approval of Prior Minutes: Minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Bob reported for Melanie that the checking account balance is \$4,846.32 of which \$1,651.42 is in scout accounts. All scouts have paid dues. Major expenses this past month included Cedars registration (hence the much lower scout account balances), Budget Storage (paid for six months) and chicken for the Court of Honor. The committee is looking for a replacement for Melanie's position as she needs to take care of her elderly mother. Please see Melanie or Mark R. if interested. The committee thanked Melanie for her efforts.

Outdoor/Activities: Bill & E.J. reported that the May campout will be held at Mark Roberts' lake. Mark has two canoes, so there will be canoeing and fishing as well as other activities (possibly orienteering). The group also will practice packing canoes for the July Niobrara trip (date to be determined). For the July trip, canoes will be rented through UNO, and there will be open fire cooking (no stoves).

Service Projects: E.J. reported for Pam that the May service project may be a Cottonwood Park clean-up and/or helping with the Cottonwood Elementary School carnival.

Equipment: E. J. reported for Mark H. that a few tents need minor repairs. Scouts will be held accountable for the tents, possibly by having the assistant patrol leader report quarterly to the Quartermaster about tents.

Advancement: Jennifer is looking for an update on who has participated in camps and service projects year-to-date. Melanie will email camping info. Pam will need to email service project info. The group discussed having the Senior Patrol Leader keeping records of participation in these events. E.J. said he'd bring this up at JLT. Ten scouts need to finish up merit badges from last year's Cedars. They have until June of this year. Jennifer also is looking for Order of Arrow info for 2008 & 2009. Brent G. will ask at the next Roundtable.
