

Opening Announcements: None.

Approval of Prior Minutes: Prior Minutes approved.

Treasurer's Report: The checking balance is \$8862.90 and includes most popcorn money but not all: also a check has not been written to MAC for the popcorn yet. \$3309.07 in scout account, includes most popcorn but not all, (some still have to get their money to Mrs. Arnett). Big expenses since last meeting: tents @ \$783.45, partially offset by \$575.10 deposited from the garage sale. Note that we charged each boy \$25.00 for shotgun shootout (\$350.00 total), actual expenses that have been paid so far to Mr. Davis and Mr. Martin are \$427.49.

Outdoor activities: Little Sioux campout-- Emergency Campout. Mr. Krenk will bring equipment and do a mock scenario while at camp and work with emergency first aid and situations that the scouts will participate in. Some Webelos will attend. No December campout. January campout will be announced, but discussion was that it may be at Mahoney State Park.

Service Projects: December Open Door Mission, It was discussed that they have a food drive and they may want scouts to help deliver food to families in need and that may occur on December 19th, but will be announced later. Bob Griffiths mentioned that we may deliver food from his companies food drive to families, and he will check on it further.

Advancement Coordinator: none for the evening

Equipment Coordinator: Discussion was held on how to mark the new tents to keep them in order and to catalog them when they are being used. Mr. Krenk mentioned that he would work with the new Quarter Master to get the patrol packs up to par.

Membership Coordinator: Bob Griffiths visited troop 285 den meeting and he states that we may have 6 scouts from Den 374 and 4 scouts from Den 285 on this campout at Little Sioux and we should be prepared to have enough food to plan for them so the numbers were increased for each patrol organizing food for the campout and that the troop should supplement extra cost for the cubs. None of the Webelos are spending the night. We talked about hopeful good recruiting this year for new scouts to our Troop.

Webmaster: Rick Stein said that the card information needed attention. The fee was still being paid but it states the card is invalid and expired and needs to log in and update information, Information was given to Mr. Griffiths. A new position for scouts is now available and it involves a Webmaster Position. Discussion was made about the safety of keeping personal information and identities private to guard the safety of all involved. The facts of how this would be carried out, and who is able to access this was discussed and Mr. Stein is going to check out what could be done further. For scouts to be involved more in the website. Discussion was made on the safety and the procedure on the internet for our scouts.

Round Table: they want their Charter by their next meeting, so some people who haven't been in attendance will be contacted and followed up on. The new Webmaster position was mentioned at the Round Table also.

Scout Master Report: Mr. Krenk stated that Greens are underway, and turn in green sales next week and then you have one more week after that.

Final notes and discussion:

Bob mentioned that discussion was made about the Troop supplying books and scarves and slides for new scouts coming into the Troop. And it was agreed that this would continue. Mr. Stein stated that he is willing to conduct a Computer Merit Badge class in January and it was discussed to do it on Saturday January 23, 2010 and that this could be accomplished in one day.

More details for it will be announced later.

January campout will be the third weekend and falls on January 16th, 2010.

Mr. Krenk stated that we will conduct a ceremony at Little Sioux in the new Chapel to commemorate the event of being there and the scouts that were involved in the accident in our Troop and others.
